

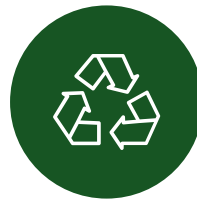
# CHANGE IN REFUSE SERVICES COLLECTION

In response to the concerns of residents regarding illegal dumping, the Division of Refuse Collection will begin changing out the current 300-gallon refuse containers for **90-gallon containers** and **64-gallon recycling containers**. These new 90-gallon containers are tied to individual households and will be delivered to the front of your home on **Saturday, May 4, 2024**. The existing 300-gallon containers will also be removed at this time. Normal collection of containers will resume Wednesday, May 8 (Zone 3 Residents) or Thursday, May 9 (Zone 4 Residents). You will receive a formal letter from the Department of Public Service, but please be aware of the following changes.



## DELIVERY

Containers will be delivered to your front yard. Please store on your property between pick-up days.



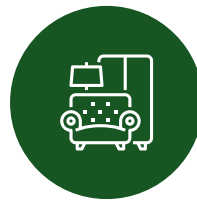
## RECYCLING

Recycling containers will also be provided and collected on Fridays.



## COLLECTION DAY

Collection days will not change. Trash will be picked up on either Wednesday or Thursday, based on zone.



## BULK COLLECTION

Residents can schedule a bulk pickup (large items like furniture) through 311. Selected dates will vary.



## CONTAINMENT

Trash should be bagged, tied or sealed, and placed inside your container. No loose bags will be picked up.



## YARD WASTE

Yard waste will be collected on the front curb and should be bagged or placed in an appropriate container.



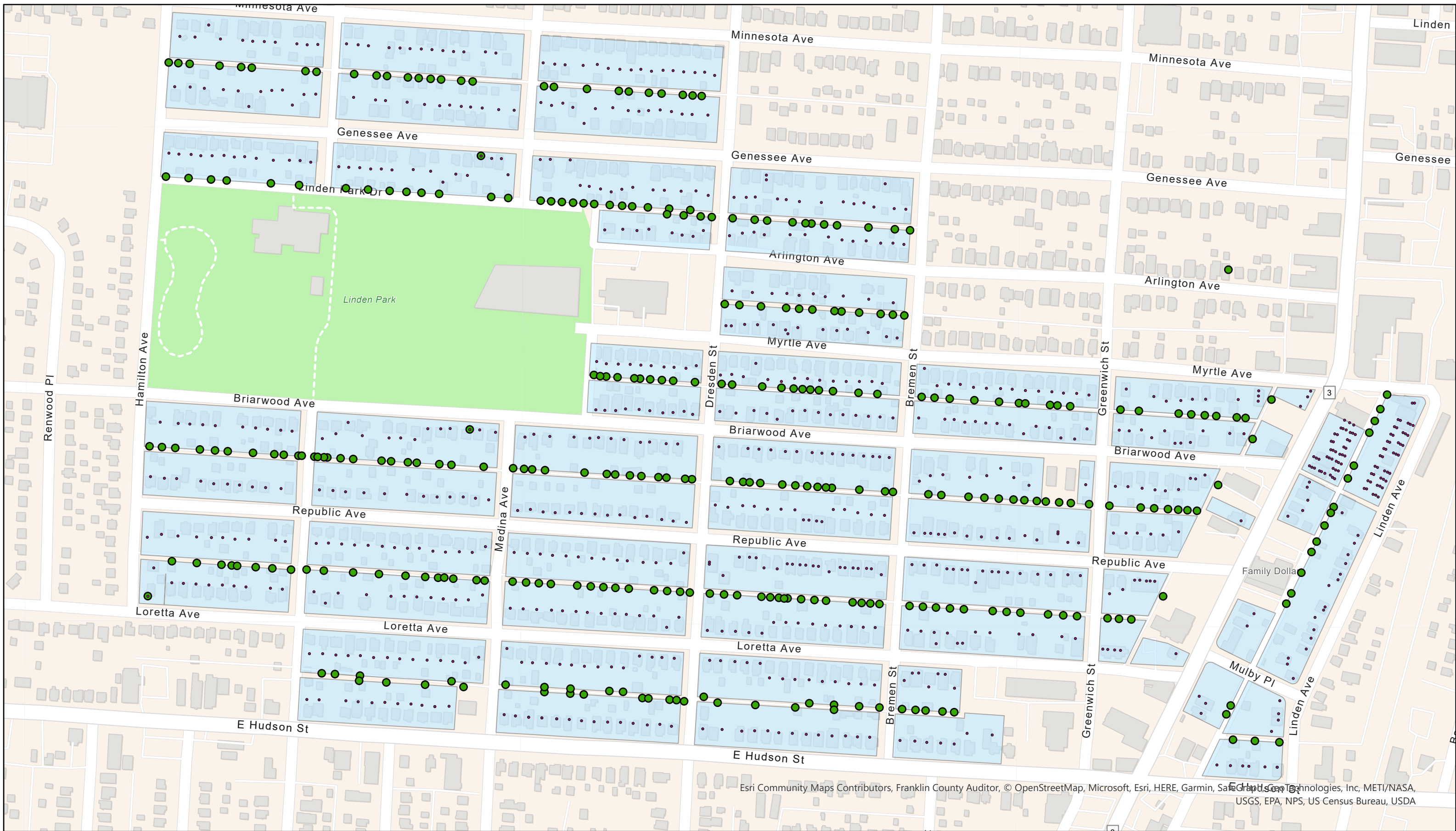
## CONTAINER STORAGE

Containers should be placed in the alley (exact location in letter) and removed from the alley after collection.
